Revelation 15 ESV

1 Then I saw another sign in heaven, great and amazing, seven angels with seven plagues, which are the last, for with them the wrath of God is finished. 2 And I saw what appeared to be a sea of glass mingled with fire—and also those who had conquered the beast and its image and the number of its name, standing beside the sea of glass with harps of God in their hands. 3 And they sing the song of Moses, the servant of God, and the song of the Lamb, saying,

"Great and amazing are your deeds, O Lord God the Almighty! Just and true are your ways, O King of the nations! 4 Who will not fear, O Lord, and glorify your name? For you alone are holy. All nations will come and worship you, for your righteous acts have been revealed."

5 After this I looked, and the sanctuary of the tent of witness in heaven was opened, 6 and out of the sanctuary came the seven angels with the seven plagues, clothed in pure, bright linen, with golden sashes around their chests. 7 And one of the four living creatures gave to the seven angels seven golden bowls full of the wrath of God who lives forever and ever, 8 and the sanctuary was filled with smoke from the glory of God and from his power, and no one could enter the sanctuary until the seven plagues of the seven angels were finished.

Signs in Heaven This is the third sign that John saw. What were the previous two signs? 12:1-3

Plagues of Wrath The 7 angels have the 7 last plagues (remember 7 is the number of perfection or completion). What is the purpose of God pouring out His wrath on the inhabitants of the earth?

Songs The angels sang two songs in response to the victory over the Anti-Christ, his image, and the number of his name.

What is the Song of Moses and why would they be singing it? 15:3; Exod.15:21

What is the Song of the Lamb? 15:3-4

What do you learn about God and man in these songs?

What similarities do you see in the two songs?

Heavenly Temple What is significant about the 7 angels being in and coming out of the temple in heaven? 15:5-8 (Compare Isaiah 6:1-13; Ezekiel 43:1-12 esp 10-12)

Your Sanctification The song of the Lamb addresses God as holy. His temple is all about His holiness. His plagues of wrath are all about His holiness. Ezekiel 43:10-12 is God's call to be ashamed of our sins, to repent and be holy.
