

The Dragon is Defeated Revelation 20:1-10

Big Idea: When it looks like evil will control the world, remember that Satan is both defeated and destined for judgment.

Event One: Satan is Bound.

Revelation 20:1-3 ESV 1 Then I saw an angel coming down from heaven, holding in his hand the key to the bottomless pit and a great chain. 2 And he seized the dragon, that ancient serpent, who is the devil and Satan, and bound him for a thousand years, 3 and threw him into the pit, and shut it and sealed it over him, so that he might not deceive the nations any longer, until the thousand years were ended. After that he must be released for a little while.

7 And when the thousand years are ended, Satan will be released from his prison 8 and will come out to deceive the nations that are at the four corners of the earth, Gog and Magog, to gather them for battle; their number is like the sand of the sea. 9 And they marched up over the broad plain of the earth and surrounded the camp of the saints and the beloved city, but fire came down from heaven and consumed them, 10 and the devil who had deceived them was thrown into the lake of fire and sulfur where the beast and the false prophet were, and they will be tormented day and night forever and ever.

APPLICATION:

Don't despair because of the evil in the world. Judgment is coming.

Even in the millennial reign of Christ on earth, some inhabitants will only pretend to worship him. When Satan is unleashed, they will quickly turn to follow him. A perfect reign and a perfect environment cannot change the human heart. Only Jesus can. Has he changed your heart?
