Revelation 19 ESV

4 And the twenty-four elders and the four living creatures fell down and worshiped God who was seated on the throne, saying, "Amen. Hallelujah!" 5 And from the throne came a voice saying, "Praise our God, all you his servants, you who fear him, small and great."

6 Then I heard what seemed to be the voice of a great multitude, like the roar of many waters and like the sound of mighty peals of thunder, crying out, "Hallelujah! For the Lord our God the Almighty reigns. 7 Let us rejoice and exult and give him the glory, for the marriage of the Lamb has come, and his Bride has made herself ready; 8 it was granted her to clothe herself with fine linen, bright and pure"—for the fine linen is the righteous deeds of the saints. 9 And the angel said to me, "Write this: Blessed are those who are invited to the marriage supper of the Lamb." And he said to me, "These are the true words of God." 10 Then I fell down at his feet to worship him, but he said to me, "You must not do that! I am a fellow servant with you and your brothers who hold to the testimony of Jesus. Worship God." For the testimony of Jesus is the spirit of prophecy.

The Groom is none other than the Son of God.

Parable: Matt. 22:1-6

He possesses all salvation, glory, and power.

His judgments are true and just.

He has conquered evil.

The Bride of Christ is the Church, bright and pure.

Eph. 5:22-28 The purity of the Bride

What is the Bride wearing? She is dressed with the righteous deeds of the saints. (v.8)

Apply: Don't show up naked for your own wedding!

The guests are Old Testament/Tribulation believers.

The rest of the story: The Warrior Groom

What significant victories is the multitude shouting about in Rev 19:1-3?

What is said and shouted that is true about God 1-3, 6b

In an atmosphere of the 24 elders worshipping God (see also Rev 4), what did the voice from the throne command? Who is on the throne (Rev 4-5)?

Ladies: If married, what was it like for you as a bride to get ready for your wedding? What was so special about getting ready and being presented to your groom?

Men: If married, what was it like for you to anticipate your wedding day and your bride coming down the aisle toward you and then taking your arm?

What was so special about having guests at your wedding?

Review: Who are the Groom, the Bride, and the Guests in Rev 19? Why are righteousness deeds so important for the Groom?

What is so special about being guests at the marriage supper of the Bride and Groom?

How can you, as part of the Bride of Christ, prepare yourself for Christ the Groom today?
