Heaven is a new earth.

1 Then I saw a new heaven and a new earth, for the first heaven and the first earth had passed away, and the sea was no more.

Heaven is a beautiful city.

2 And I saw the holy city, new Jerusalem, coming down out of heaven from God, prepared as a bride adorned for her husband.

Heaven is a place where man dwells with God.

3 "Behold, the dwelling place of God is with man. He will dwell with them, and they will be his people, and God himself will be with them as their God."

Heaven is a place of separation from ungodliness.

27 But nothing unclean will ever enter it, nor anyone who does what is detestable or false, but only those who are written in the Lamb's book of life.

Heaven is a place of unimaginable splendor.

10-11 And he carried me away in the Spirit to a great, high mountain, and showed me the holy city Jerusalem coming down out of heaven from God, having the glory of God, its radiance like a most rare jewel, like a jasper, clear as crystal.

Heaven is a place where sorrows cease.

What will be the <u>spiritual</u> state of those in heaven? Rev 21: 6-8 (compare 1 John2:28-3:3) By what means is this received? Who will be there? (see also 21:24-27) Who will not be there and what is the second death?
