**Review:** Revelation 1-21

**Big Idea:** The conclusion of this prophecy should be the beginning of a life-long desire to see Jesus return. Until then, you can overcome, because he's already won!

### **Revelation 22** ESV

6 And he said to me, "These words are trustworthy and true. And the Lord, the God of the spirits of the prophets, has sent his angel to show his servants what must soon take place." 7 "And behold, I am coming soon. Blessed is the one who keeps the words of the prophecy of this book." 8 I, John, am the one who heard and saw these things.

12 "Behold, I am coming soon, bringing my recompense with me, to repay everyone for what he has done. 13 I am the Alpha and the Omega, the first and the last, the beginning and the end."

20 He who testifies to these things says, "Surely I am coming soon." Amen. Come, Lord Jesus!

**You can count on Revelation to come true. (6) 2 Peter 1:21**

**You can count on the return of Jesus. (7) 2 Peter 3:8-9**

**You can count on no time to repent when Jesus comes. (11)**

## **LifeGroup Study Guide**

### **Come Lord Jesus Revelation 22:7-21**

**Promise** What is the greatest promise that someone on earth made to you? How did that promise make you feel?

What promise did Jesus give **22:6, 12, 20** ? Compare to John 14:1-6; Acts 1:11; 2 Pet 3:3-9. What does soon mean, in light of the fact that John was writing Revelation in the first century?

Read 2 Timothy 4:8 and 1 Peter 1:8. What do Paul and Peter say about Jesus' return and love? How can we cultivate this love?

**Blessing 22:7, 14** Review the seven blessings (beatitudes) of Revelation (1:3; 14:3; 16:15; 19:9; 20:6; 22:7; 22:14)  
What two blessings are given in this chapter, what do they mean, and how can we realize them?

**Worship 22: 8-9** What commandment does the angel give John to do until Jesus comes?

**Sealed 22:10-11** What does the angel say not to seal? Why? What does he say is sealed? Why? Compare Daniel 12:9-10

**Name 22:12-16** Look again at the Name of Jesus as He describes Himself. What do these names mean in light of His promise to come again?
