LifeSpring Church has an opportunity to grow a legacy. Not a legacy of brick and mortar but a legacy of Christ-followers, equipped to make disciples of each succeeding generation. Our mission is not to build buildings but to build people.

Yet, we have experienced that adequate and strategic space is crucial for reaching and equipping people. We must address the problem of overcrowding in both the children's areas and the lobby, as well as the need to open up additional spaces for student and adult groups. That's what Phase 3 is all about.

The Building Implementation Group and senior staff have been working with Brown Church Development Group and Halo Architects to refine preliminary plans for a new building addition, Phase 3. Floor plans and outside elevations have been drawn. Also, an exciting animation has been produced which will allow members to “walk through” the major spaces of the building.

Pray fervently for our church in this crucial time. God is moving mightily in LSC to change lives! Join Him in his work by going “all in” during this capital campaign by attending each Sunday, as well as one of the Vision Meetings. It’s all about growing a legacy—a legacy of changed lives.

What would phase 3 include?

- a two-story children’s building on the northwest corner of our current lobby: preschoolers upstairs, children downstairs. Both with secure entries. Both levels will have large gathering rooms.
- an indoor, enclosed playground on the main level, adjoining the lobby.
- a greatly expanded, upscale lobby with room for fellowship, ministry booths, space to gather with friends, and a café.
- adult classroom space due to children vacating existing children’s classrooms.
- additional rooms for students.
- much greater hallway space and a feel of openness.

Why is this so important?

This new construction and remodeling project would help alleviate some of our greatest hindrances to reaching and assimilating people: packed hallways, a crowded lobby, little adult space, overcrowding in our Worship KidStyle, preschool, and children’s classrooms, and unsecured children’s spaces.

GIVE A GIFT OF ASSETS

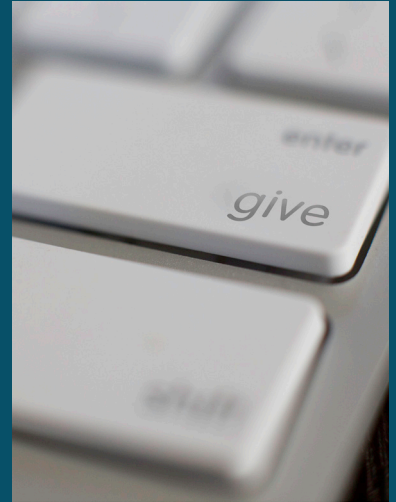
