SOVEREIGNTY OF GOD

A theological term which refers to the unlimited power of God, who has sovereign control over the affairs of nature and history.

PROVIDENCE

The continuous activity of God in His creation by which He preserves and governs. The doctrine of providence affirms God's absolute lordship over His creation and confirms the dependence of all creation on the Creator. It is the denial of the idea that the universe is governed by chance or fate. (Nelson's Illustrated Bible Dictionary)
